2. Pot of any other preserve. *M, H*
3. 3 Scotch Eggs (leave whole). *M, H, R.*
4. 4 Plain Meringues. *M, H, R.*
5. Treacle Tart. *M, H,*
6. Fruit Cake (to given recipe below). *M, H, R*

8 ozs. Self Raising Flour.	$\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. Salt.	1 tsp. Mixed Spice.
4 ozs. Margarine.	4 ozs. Caster.	9 ozs. Mixed Fruit (dried).
1 tsp. Grated Orange Rind.	1 Egg.	$\frac{3}{4}$ Gill Milk.
6" Tin.	360° or Gas 4.	Middle Shelf.

Sift flour, salt and spice. Rub fat into flour, stir in sugar, dried fruit and orange rind. Hollow out centre of mixture and add beaten egg with milk. Mix to soft dropping consistency.
