CHOCOLATE CAKE: 4 ozs. Margarine. 4 ozs. Caster Sugar.

5 ozs. Self Raising Flour (if Plain Flour, use  $1\frac{1}{2}$  tspns. baking 1 tblsp. Golden Syrup.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ozs. Chocolate Powder powder.

OR 1 oz. Cocoa.

2 Eggs and a <u>little Milk.</u> Few drops of Vanilla Essence.

7 inch Cake Tin.

METHOD: Cream margarine, sugar, syrup and essence until soft and light. Sieve dry ingredients. Beat eggs well. Stir eggs alternately, with dry mixture, into the creamed mixture. Grease and flour tin and bake for 14 hours. 375°F - Gas Mark 4.
